

Intense training, weapons and knowledge of their enemies made the Roman Empire successful.

The influence of the Romans can still be seen today in Britain.



### KEY VOCABULARY

<b>Empire</b>	A group of countries ruled by a King or Queen
<b>Invade</b>	When an army goes into a country with the intention to take over
<b>Julius Caesar</b>	A Roman general who helped build ancient roman into a powerful empire
<b>Republic</b>	A group that is run by the people with an elected representative
<b>Monarchy</b>	A state/country that has a King or Queen
<b>Boudicca</b>	A celtic Queen that who rose up against the Romans.
