SunSmart Sun Protection Policy

At Pinner Wood School we want staff and pupils to enjoy the sun safely. We will work with staff, pupils and parents to achieve this through:

EDUCATION – these measures are in place:

- All pupils will have at least one SunSmart lesson per year.
- We will talk about how to be SunSmart in assemblies at the start of the summer term.
- Parents and carers will be given a reminder in our newsletter explaining what the school is doing about sun protection and how they can help at the beginning of the summer term.

PROTECTION – this is an ongoing project

- **Shade:**
- More trees and shrubs from the Woodland Trust have been planted on the site.
- A free standing permanent gazebo has been purchased with a donation from the Friends of Pinner Wood for the lower school playground. This provides shade for groups of children throughout the day and for parents waiting to collect their children.
- In the Year 6 playground shade is to be found in the Quiet Area. Benches are positioned in the shade also.

Timetabling:

- Our sports days start at the beginning of the school day. This will allow parents who work to join us for activities in the morning.
- Outside play for foundation stage children will be restricted and monitored between 11am and 3 pm.

Clothing:

- All children will be encouraged to wear hats when outside and during sports lessons.

Sunscreen:

- We cannot currently supply sunscreen to pupils unless extenuating circumstances apply. Parents should apply a high factor sunscreen before school.
- Sunscreen use will be encouraged on school trips and parents will be reminded by letter.
