Statement of Behaviour Principles

This statement has been drawn up in accordance with the Educational Inspections Act, 2006 and DfE guidance (Behaviour and Discipline in Schools, 2012). It is the responsibility of the Governing body to:

- Make, and from time to time review, a written statement of general principles to guide the headteacher in determining measures to promote good behaviour and discipline amongst pupils.

This statement is to be taken in conjunction with the schools positive behaviour policy and home school agreement which are reviewed and approved every year by the governing body.

Our principles are that:

- Children's behaviour will enable them and their peers to learn as effectively as possible
- Staff and pupils will be polite and respectful at all times, to each other and to visitors
- Any form of discrimination or bullying will be addressed promptly
- Staff and the Governing Body will provide opportunities for pupils to take responsibility and be involved in decision making
- Expectations of both staff and pupils will be explicit and consistent
- Staff will be fair and consistent and foster an productive culture in which pupils' achievements are recognised and celebrated
- Staff will be empowered to take prompt and effective action when pupils behave inappropriately
- The school will work in partnership with home and external agencies to maximise the chances the chances of every pupil behaving responsibly.

This policy will be reviewed by the Governors on a 2 year basis.
