





Seesaw is a simple way for teachers and students to record and share what's happening in the classroom.

Seesaw gives students a place to document their learning, be creative and learn how to use technology.

Each student gets their own journal and will add things to it, like photos, videos, drawings, or notes.







When there are new Seesaw posts, families can be notified via app notification, email or SMS.

Parents are only notified about their own child's work, and all data is safe and secure.







Students love Seesaw because they can show their work in a variety of ways, sharing their work with meaningful audiences, all whilst practising those important 21st Century skills.



Get Seesaw for Your Device Seesaw requires an invitation from your child's teacher in order to subscribe.

2: On any mobile device using the Seesaw Class app (it must be the class app NOT the family app)









When logging on the children should choose

Your child/ren's teacher will have sent home a login sheet for your child to use. This will include a Text Code and a QR code.

The children can use either code to access their journal.








When your child logs in they will see their home screen.

Any new activities can be seen under the activities tab.

Any work that has been approved and marked by the teacher can be seen in the journal.

Any messages can be seen in Inbox





The activity will include instructions from their teacher.

Your child presses +Add Response to add a response to their task.

This could include taking a picture, inserting a link, videoing themselves or uploading a document. (Not all work will need a response e.g. Timestables Rockstars)

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
Stone Age Project Autumn 1
