Journey	Journey: Children will learn how explore how the films have changed since they were created in 1891. Children will explore how different elements were added at later dates and understand that people do not visit the movies as often as they did. The children will compare how football has changed over the decades starting from the date it was first televised to the materials used for the ball. The children then continue to explore how lives have changed with the evolving internet, technology and fashion. Children will then go on to explore how music has changed over the decades. The children will explore milestones of the television, starting from its birth to its current form - colour, surround sound etc. Show stopper: The children will create an information video showcasing their knowledge and comparing how times, technology, music and fashion has changed over time.
