These are Winter, Spring, Summer, Autumn.</p> <p>In Winter it is cold, some trees have no leaves and you must wrap up warm.</p> <p>In Spring it is mild, trees begin to grow new leaves, some flowers like daffodils begin to grow. Animals are born.</p> <p>In Summer, the weather is warm. We wear sunglasses and sun hats. There are lots of leaves on trees and flowers.</p> <p>In Autumn on many trees the leaves change colour and fall off.</p> <p>An evergreen tree keeps its green leaves all year round, even in the winter.</p> <p>A deciduous tree loses its leaves each year</p>	

<p><b>Our Curriculum Journey</b></p>	<p><b>Stunning Start:</b> Children will plant radish seeds, they will make predictions on what they think will happen. Over the next few weeks they will observe changes.</p> <p><b>Journey:</b> children will look at how leaves change across the seasons, they will learn the definition evergreen and deciduous trees and that some trees do not lose their leaves in winter. Children will identify flowers common for each season. They will look at the key features of a plant and will write up how they planted their radishes and what happened after a number of weeks after planting radish seeds.</p> <p><b>Show stopper:</b> Children will create a Plants and seasons booklets for young gardeners. This will show which plants and flowers can be found in each season and explain key definitions such as evergreen and deciduous</p>
