Develop dribbling skills in Hockey and how to hold properly.</p>				<b>Key Facts/Sticky Knowledge</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Sprint to collect a ball on the whistle</li> <li>- Must only hit an opponent between the head and the knee</li> <li>- If you catch the ball, the opponent is out</li> <li>- A ball is live until it hits the floor</li> <li>- Players can use a ball to block an incoming ball</li> </ul>	

<p><b>Our Curriculum Journey</b></p>	<p><b>Journey:</b> In this unit, the children will explore catching a dodgeball from different heights. This is where the rules will be clarified to the children. The children will learn how to hold the ball correctly and will practise aiming it at a target. Next, the children learn how to dodge and block a ball. Here, they have to be quick thinking and use the dodge, run, block method. To put all this into play, the children will have a go at some dodgeball matches.</p>
