Key Facts/Sticky Knowledge	 Sometimes people get bullied because they are seer to be different. It is ok to be different from my friends because sometimes we like different things. It is ok for boys to like something a girl likes. It is ok for girls to like something a boy likes. A stereotype is an often unfair and untrue belief that many people have about all people or things. 	
Our Curriculum Journey	Journey: At the beginning of this unit children will look at a range of duvet covers and decide whether they are suited for a girl, boy or both. The children will discuss ways boys and girls are similar and different, thinking about hobbies and clothes that they wear. Children will celebrate their differences recording this on a shield. Jigsaw Jo will present scenarios to the children which the children will act out and decided which scenes they think is bullying. Towards the end of the unit, children will read the story of Bella, Billy and B to explore gender diversity and stereotypes and will think of a suitable present for their birthday.
