Our Curriculum Journey	<p>The children begin by looking at the KQ: What does Peace mean to Christians at Christmas?</p> <p>We go over what peace means across all religions. The children then write what inner and outer peace means to them. This follows on to The Old Testament scripture and the children learn that it was a prophecy made 700 years before the birth of Christ. They also learn the importance of why Jesus is referred to as the Prince of peace. The children then design their own peace symbol and upload this on to Seesaw.</p>
