This is known as the Wudhu. Salah refers to five prayers that Muslims perform daily. Physical actions to accompany prayer are known as rak'ah. In a Mosque the mihrab marks the direction of prayer. Prayer constitutes one pillar of Islam and is considered the foundation of the religion.

Our Curriculum Journey	Journey: The series of lessons begin with thinking about the overarching key question - Why do people pray? Islam is introduced and the next key question is, 'How do Muslims pray?' This will include learning the reasons for prayer and how to prepare for prayer. The children will learn the five daily prayers and the actions that accompany them. The next lesson is learning about where Muslims pray which centres on the mosque. The learning then focusses on why Muslims pray and what the purpose of that prayer is. The learning concludes with thinking back to the original question about why people pray and the consideration of any changes in viewpoints.
