The World – Past and Present

The world is yours to discover! Travel back in time to find out about the beginning of human existence, ancient civilisations and historic events that have shaped our world. Explore countries and continents and learn about rivers, rocks and weather. Investigate your local environment and the UK. Find out how people live all over the world.

Leadership

We want you to take responsibility for your school. To help us we have a Junior Leadership Team and many opportunities for you to lead across the whole spectrum of school life. We have a democratically elected School Council which helps to run our school and makes important decisions for the future.

Performing

We have two choirs, an orchestra and guitar club as well as lessons for a full range of instruments (woodwind, strings, brass, keyboard). We are eco-warriors at Pinner Wood, inspired and led by our Eco group who hold regular events and meetings to raise awareness of important issues facing our planet and our future.

Languages

Many languages are spoken by pupils and staff and specific language groups meet regularly. We learn French from Year 3-6.

We love reading at Pinner Wood. Our aim is for every child to be able to read well. Our teachers dedicate time to reading us stories and poems to enjoy. Our well-resourced school library and book corners are stocked with books to borrow and take home.

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Oracy at Pinner Wood
